





















Our purpose?

To make Jesus known and to grow in our knowledge, love and service of God.

How?

- > through our worship, prayer, teaching of scripture, music, and sacraments
- > by caring for and serving our parish community and the world around us.

Where?

To facilitate these activities, we maintain the fabric of St Weonards Church and Churchyard.







Our vision? What are we hoping for?

- ✓ To see a regular worshipping congregation of >50 people within the next 3-5 years, and to grow disciples ... e.g.
- ✓ # children & young people baptised and attending
- ✓ # confirmed
- ✓ # weddings and funerals
- ✓ # reintroduction of mid-week service, school services and visits
- ✓ # prayer / Bible study / theological reflection groups







What's the issue?

- The church's audio equipment dates from 1980s/90s and does not offer the capabilities we'd like as we look ahead to 2030
- For the last 12 years, All Age services have relied on personal home equipment, requiring set-up / removal on each occasion
- The current analogue to digital audio conversion does not provide reliable sound or video output for streaming services.







Practicalities: what would it look like?

A permanent installation offering:

- ✓ Good quality microphones for officiants and users of all ages
- ✓ Clear sound output throughout the church, including for the hearing impaired
- ✓ A large main display screen for all forms of visual content, for wider community use, + chancel display
- ✓ Simple-to-operate streaming equipment that we can offer to families at christenings, weddings, funerals, as well as for regular services
- ✓ Extra sockets for musicians







What will the solution provide? (the project brief)

- ✓ Improve audibility and intelligibility of spoken word
- ✓ Full coverage of wireless microphones throughout the building
- ✓ Enable wireless playback of audio tracks
- ✓ Provide a bright, crisp image even in a well-lit environment
- ✓ Enable streaming of services & events to the internet
- ✓ Require minimal set-up time
- ✓ Be simple and intuitive for users of varying abilities









Purpose?

- ✓ To enhance the audio-visual experience for regular worshippers, for those participating in life event services, and other users
- ✓ To be able to display images and video content that appeal to younger worshippers and visitors
- ✓ To make St Weonard's Church an exciting choice for worship, educational school trips, concerts, and community events
- ✓ To help us grow our congregations and number of supporters.









Key elements of the proposal?

- Audio upgrade: loudspeakers, microphones, system control
- Visual solution: projection screen, projector, controls, laptop, plus foldback monitor for service leader in chancel.
- Streaming solution: camera, streaming box, microphones.
- → All with design, installation (~10 days), training & commissioning







Who is installing the equipment?

How is this project approved?

Prayerful consideration by PCC \rightarrow decision in principle to go ahead with all or part of the project.

- 1) Audio solution 'List B' application \rightarrow approval by Archdeacon ✓ completed June 2024
- 2) Visual/streaming solution Faculty application \rightarrow endorsement by DAC October 2024 → Registrar → review and decision by Chancellor.









The costs are very significant – but we're investing in key infrastructure for the next generation:

- 1) Audio solution: £16,800 incl. VAT ✓ completed June 2024
- 2) Visual solution: £19,300 incl. VAT with long-throw projector
- 3) Streaming solution: £3,000 incl. VAT +5% contingency: £1,200
- 4) New radiant heaters in choir: ~£1,000 incl. VAT

Balance of project to fund: £24,500 incl. VAT

TOTAL PROJECT COST £41,300







The Diocesan Advisory Committee has approved our application.

It's now at the consultation stage. Members of the public may make representations to inform the Diocesan Registrar until 21 November 2024.

It will visible for everyone in the nave but it won't obscure the altar






With this equipment, we'll be able to:

- ✓ Screen video or film clips to illustrate sermons or reflections
- ✓ Offer wedding couples the option of a recording of their service
- ✓ Show photos of loved ones before a funeral or memorial service
- ✓ Enhance educational visits by primary school children
- ✓ Provide the wider St Weonards community with an attractive place to hold an event requiring slides and/or music
- ✓ Offer other churches an alternative venue for meetings
- ✓ (Perhaps) be a Promoter for Arts Alive and screen 'Flicks in the Sticks' films
- ✓ Host Archenfield Arts Festival events (again)
- ✓ Live-stream in a more professional yet simple-to-operate way to those who currently join St Weonards services on Zoom


